We need your registration no later than two weeks before the conference, which is enough time to cancel any unused rooms at the Battlefield Inn. However, please send in your registration no matter how close to the conference date!! We will re-book rooms as needed.

Policy Regarding Reimbursement of Expenses

Miscellaneous Notes

DO NOT TELL THEM THAT YOU WANT A ROOM OUT OF THE STORM BLOCK. This will cause confusion. The confusion will be so great that they will not be able to make your reservation. The hotel can call you back to make your reservation. You can avoid all this confusion and delay if you will just tell the hotel that you want an independent reservation that you will be paying on your own.
